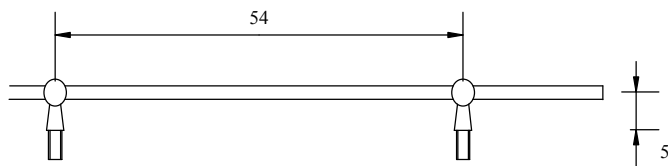
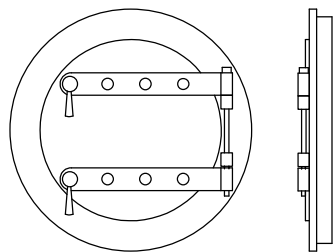


Chimney, brass



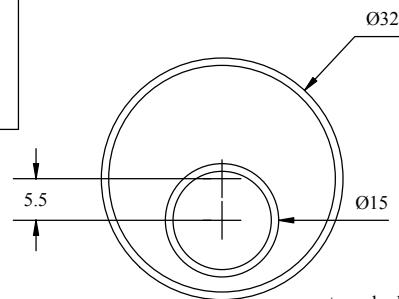
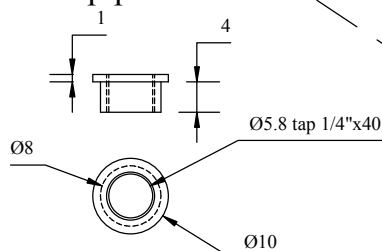
Cosmetic blower pipe, use handrail knobs
screwed into boiler bushes

Smokebox front, from 3mm brass.
An opening door makes lighting
up easier. Secure to boiler shell
with a couple of 12BA (or smaller) bolts



Fit an opening smokebox door
to make lighting up easier

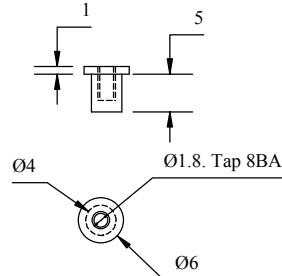
Water filler bush, locate
in front of cab, to left of
blower pipe/handrail –



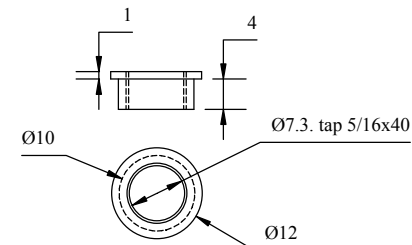
rectangular hole at least

Boiler bushes, gunmetal or bronze (NOT brass)

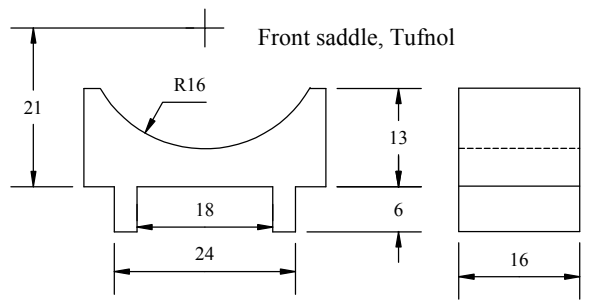
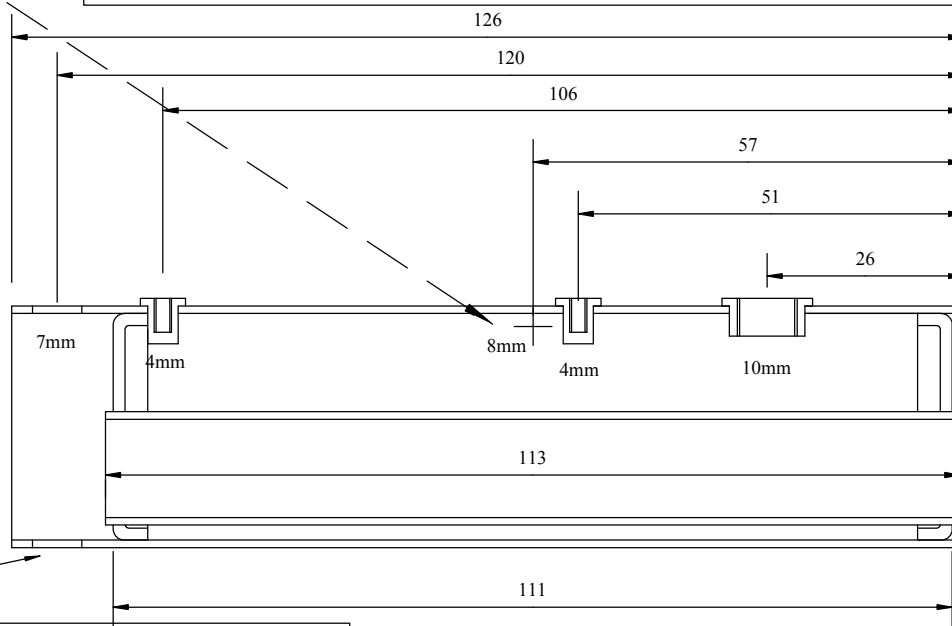
Bushes for blower pipe
supports



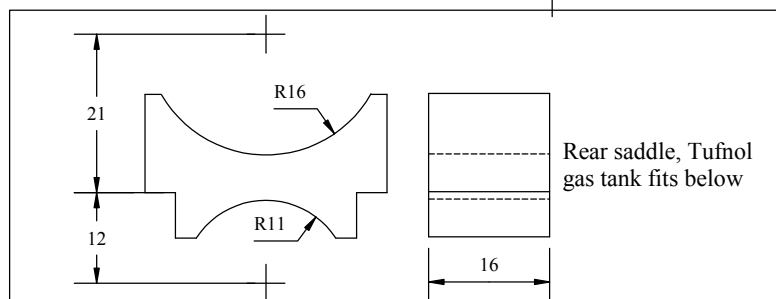
Turret bush
